

## Let's get Bucks Buzzing!

Celebrate pollinating insects with this British bee bunting.

### You will need

- colour printer
- two sheets of paper or card
- scissors
- hole-punch or awl
- about 2m of ribbon or string

### Instructions

Print these two sheets actual size. While some of the cut-lines may extend off the page, the images should fit within the margins of most home printers.

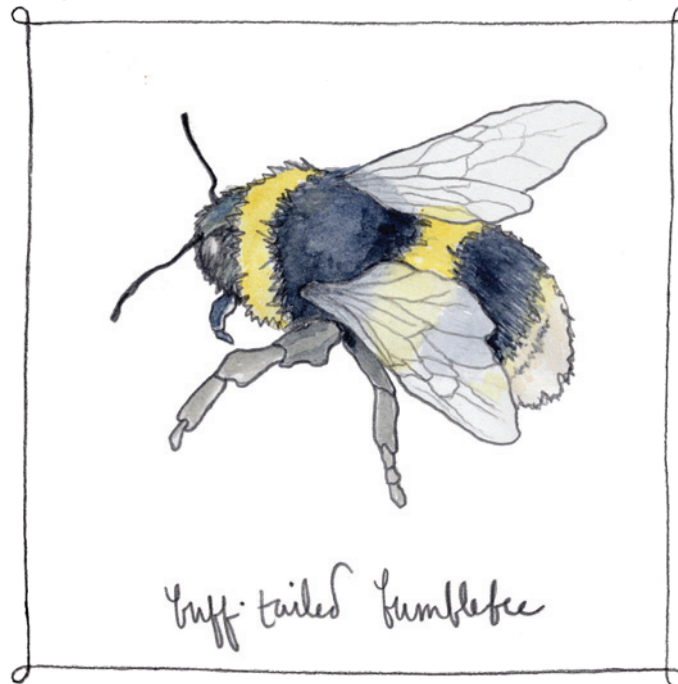
Cut along the dashed lines. Use a hole-punch or awl to make holes over the dots. You may need an adult to help you with this step.

Weave the ribbon or string through the holes and arrange the bees along the whole length. Leave around 10-20cm of string/ribbon at each end for hanging your bunting.

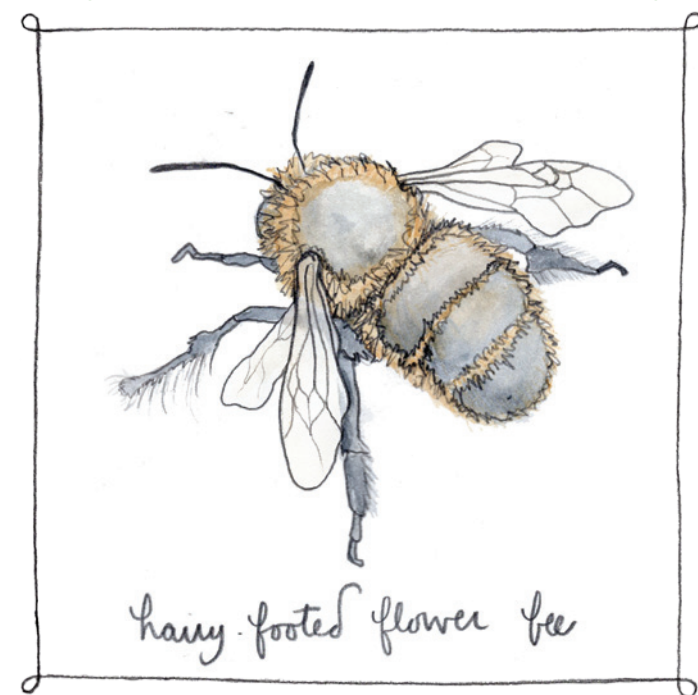

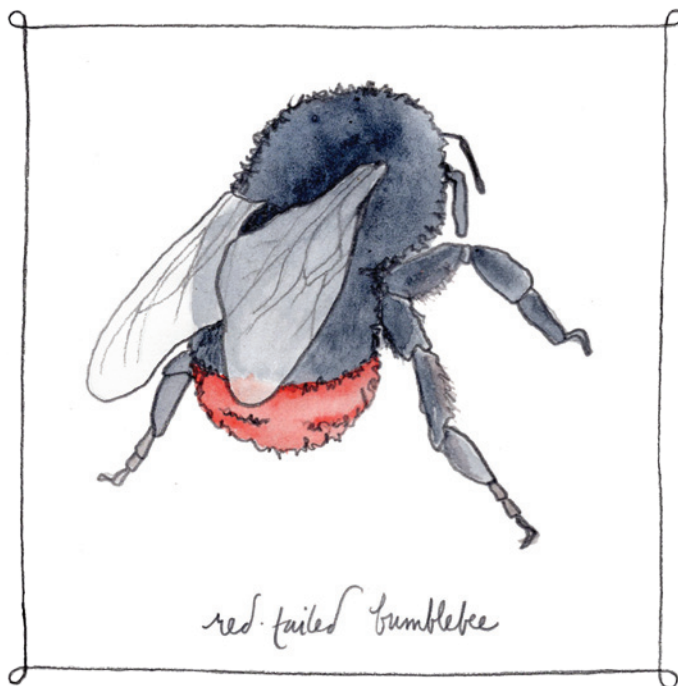

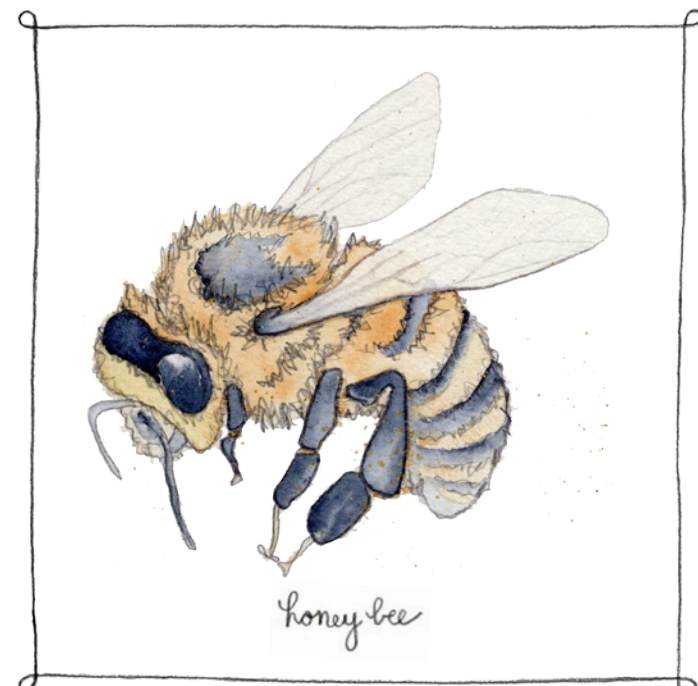
*buff-tailed bumblebee*
